### Section 1. Approval as a Domestic Insurer

A domestic insurer may, upon the approval of the commissioner of insurance, transfer its state in which it is admitted to transact the business of insurance, and upon such a transf domestic insurer, and shall be admitted to this state if qualified as a foreign insurer. insurance shall approve the proposed transfer unless he or she determines the transfer is the policyholders of this state.

#### Section 3. Effects of Redomestication

The certificate of authority, agents appointments and licenses, rates and other items which insurancnew location unless so ordered by the conemissionsurance.
