2.2 The Authority shall improve regulatory and exchange information and insurance regulatory communication and matters of common interest.

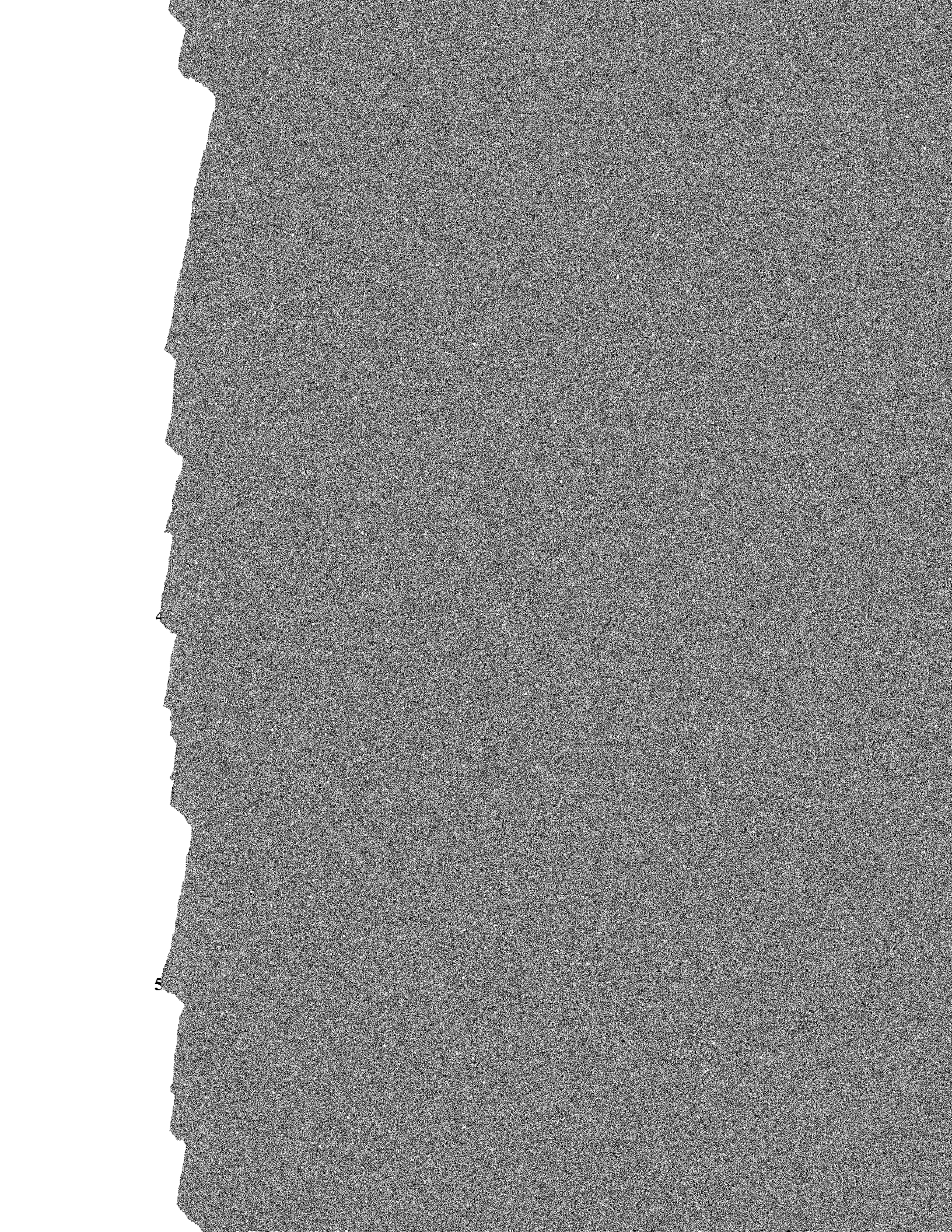
2.3 The Authority shall
