  - (c) Use of a certification or professional designation that indicates or implies a leve of occupational qualifications obtained through education, training or experience that the insurance producesing the certification or designation does not have; and
  - (d) Use of a certification or professional designation that was obtained from a certifying ordesignating organization that:
    - (i) Is primarily engaged in the business of instruction in sales or marketing;
