The Subgroup determined that a new model act and new model regulation should be adopted. The Shrort Health Policies Providing Long-term Care Benefits (B) Subgroup was disbaradedede 2016 Fall National Meeting.

The Task Force appointed the Short Duration Libertyn Care Policies (B) Subgroup at the 2016 Fall National Meeting to address LTC products of short duration that are excluded from the Long Term Care Insurance Model Act (#640) and Mode#641, but do not quite fit under the
